On 17.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.706 dated 17.11.2018, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC, at Police Station Quilla-Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact the dispute was resolved and Dheeraj and Pankaj have agreed to return the alleged amount of Rs.6.00 lakhs. He further submits that the aforesaid amount was sought to be repaid through six post dated cheques of Rs.1.00 lakh each, but on presentation, the cheques were dishonoured and the present FIR was lodged. He submits that since the petitioner had not received any amount, therefore, even as per the compromise/settlement, he was not required to repay any

amount.

Notice of motion for 30.10.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Munish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed-over to him during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Pal has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 17.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
