The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.120 dated 12.07.2015 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

The operative part of the order dated 16.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a widow and she was granted anticipatory bail and thereafter, she was regularly appearing before the trial Court, however, on account of noting a wrong date, she could not appear before the trial Court on 12.04.2019 and her bail/surety bonds were cancelled. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance

to the order dated 16.09.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and released on interim bail.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Raj Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
