Grievance of the petitioner is that his suspension period with effect from 15.09.2011 to 11.06.2012, has not been considered as duty period by respondent No.2, despite repeated requests made by him. Hence, the writ petition. The petitioner also caused representation dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-9) but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion to respondents.
3. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.
4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the letter dated 25.07.2018 (Annexure P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
