The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Amit Kumar in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 06.03.2015.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.15,59,840/-, detailed hereunder:-

-Monthly income of the deceased	Rs.9,320/-
-Deduction for personal expenses	50%
-Addition in income for future prospects	50%
-Multiplier	18
-Loss of dependency	Rs.15,09,840/-
-Loss of love and affection and funeral expenses	Rs.50,000/-

Counsel for the appellants would argue that the claimants may be allowed adequate compensation under conventional heads.

I have gone through findings of the Tribunal with regard to assessment of compensation but find myself unable to accept contention of

the appellants that there is scope of allowing additional compensation particularly when the case is examined in the light of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court *National Insurance Company Limited v. Pranay Sethi and others, 2017 SC 1270*. That being so, appeal filed by the appellants merits rejection.

In view of what has been discussed hereinbefore, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed.
