ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 77, dated 03.04.2019, under Sections 379-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Section 25/54 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul, District Narnaul.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is stated that 2 accused had snatched the bag of the complainant containing ₹3,25,000/- . He also contends that the petitioner is 22 years of age and is in custody for over 5 ½ months. He is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Yogesh states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 5 ½ months, not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
