Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.51 dated 17.05.2019 under Sections 323, 506 and 365 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short, the POCSO Act) registered at Women Police Station Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated August 29, 2019 passed by this Court in **CRM-M-34137 of 2019** titled as **Rajesh Versus State of Haryana** to contend that on the similar set of allegations, co-accused Rajesh has been admitted on bail. The petitioner is in custody since 29.05.2019.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 29.05.2019 and co-accused Rajesh has already been admitted on bail on similar set of

allegations, this Court finds that petitioner Vikram is entitled to be admitted on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall decide the case without being influenced with these observations in any manner.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner shall influence the prosecution witnesses during the trial in any manner, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.
