Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to give a notice in advance under Section 160 Cr.P.C. in case the petitioners are required by the police authorities for the purpose of any investigation.

Separate short replies by way of affidavits of Superintendent of Police, Investigation, District Patiala and Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur, filed in the Court today, are taken on record. In the affidavit of DSP, it is stated that none of the petitioners is involved in any case and no complaint is pending against them, therefore, there is no question of calling them in the police station.

In the affidavit of SP, Investigation, Patiala, it is stated that

statement of petitioner Joga Singh is recorded, in which it is stated that he is not involved in any other case and he was called by the police about 01 year ago and in fact, his brother is an accused in FIR No.08 dated 13.01.2018 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Patran.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition and the same is disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.
