REKHA MITTAL, J.(Oral)

Counsel for the applicant-insurance company would state that dispute between the parties has been settled and insurance company has agreed to pay additional amount of Rs. 60,000/-, over and above compensation assessed by the Tribunal. He would further state that in view of settlement between the parties, the main appeal, fixed for 25.9.2019, may be taken on Board and disposed of accordingly. He would further inform that amount of Rs. 60,000/- shall be deposited with the Permanent Lok Adalat within a period of 40 days.

Counsel for the non-applicant-appellant concedes to the submissions made by counsel for the applicant and has got no objection if the appeal is disposed of in view of the said settlement.

In view of the above, the application is allowed. FAO No.4585 of 2017 is taken on Board today itself.

Main case

In view of submissions made by counsel for the parties, the appeal stands disposed of. The appellant shall be entitle to additional compensation to the extent of Rs. 60,000/- and the same shall be deposited by the insurance company with the Permanent Lok Adalat, within a period of 40 days from today. As the appeal has been disposed of in view of aforesaid, application for condonation of delay is of academic relevance only.
