The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.163 dated 27.07.2019 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar Rural.

The operative part of the order dated 17.09.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party stopped three persons and all of them ran away and thereafter, on search of the truck, 5 kg of poppy husk was recovered. It is further submitted that the petitioner is nominated in the FIR on the basis of suspicion.

Notice of motion for 24.10.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 17.09.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Pal Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 17.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
