In respect of her grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, on 10.07.2019, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, with the petition.

Consequently, without making any comment whatsoever on what is alleged in the petition, as also in the aforesaid representation, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent no. 3), is directed to go into the matter in detail, keeping also in view of the fact that a legal notice is stated to have been received by the petitioner qua dishonouring of a cheque issued by her, in favour of respondent no. 9, but with a compromise stated to have been reached between them on 06.08.2018, a copy of which has also been annexed as Annexure P-3.

Thus, the SSP would go into the matter and thereafter, if any action is warranted, as per law, such necessary action would be taken.

If he concludes that no action is required to be taken by the police, he would pass an order giving reasons therein, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
