Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present application.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and Annexures P-6 to P-9 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CWP-26082-2019

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the interregnum period, out of seven panches, who had been opposing the petitioner have joined hands with the Sarpanch and the Sarpanch now

enjoys the support of majority of the Panches and the coram is complete with the Sarpanch. He further states that in the impugned order dated 9.9.2019 (Annexure P-1), respondent No.2 had specifically observed that during the period of the Administrator, in case the Gram Panchayat succeeds in getting consent with each other for the development works of the village, in that eventuality, the order will be treated as cancelled with immediate effect.

Heard.

In view of the liberty granted by respondent No.2 vide impugned order dated 9.9.2019 (Annexure P-1) and as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the majority of the panches are supporting the Sarpanch (the petitioner), the Court feels that no interference is warranted in the matter. Without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner may approach the competent authority i.e. Respondent No.2 District Development and Panchayat Officer, Moga, who will take the necessary steps in view of the changed circumstances and do the needful expeditiously within two weeks from the date of such application by the petitioner.
