Petitioner Sumit has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing/setting aside the impugned order dated 19.6.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Panipat granting regular bail to the respondents-accused.

During the course of arguments it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the complainant has received the amount from the accused, which is subject matter of the FIR. It is also not disputed that the concession of bail extended to the accused has not been misused by him/them.

Considering the above, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the jurisdiction under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
