Though learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that as per the MLR there is only one injury in the stomach which was attributed to the co-accused Hitender, a perusal of the MLR does show that there is another injury to the deceased on the right side of the forehead.

Other than that, the petitioners having been named in the FIR itself, with the complainant having also testified before the learned trial Court again naming them, I see no error in the impugned order, summoning the petitioners on an application filed under Section 319 of the Cr.P.C. Consequently, this petition is dismissed.

However, nothing observed herein above shall be taken to be a comment by this Court on the merits of the case for or against the petitioners, which would, naturally, be seen by the learned trial Court on the basis of evidence led before it.
