Grievance of the petitioner, who had applied to the post of Senior Manager Law pursuant to advertisement published in January, 2019 issued by respondent-Punjab National Bank, is limited to the extent that even though 55 vacancies were advertised but the bank has issued a list of only 30 selected candidates and no intimation has been given with regard to the balance of vacancies.

2. Given the nature of order being passed, no further notice is required as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are warranted.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to orders dated 10.04.2019 (Annexure P-7) and 26.08.2019 (Annexure P-8), respectively, passed by Gauhati High Court, whereby, respondent-Bank was permitted to fill 50 posts of Senior Manager (Law) MMG Scale-III instead of 55 advertised and he contends that yet only 30 candidates have been selected.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

also applied to the respondent-Bank under Right to Information Act to seek the requisite information but the same has not been provided to him so far.

5. In the premise, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-Bank to provide requisite information to the petitioner, as sought by him under the RTI Act, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 30 days.

6. Disposed of in above terms.
