TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners seek a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 17.

Counsel for the petitioners has been heard and pleadings on record have been perused.

Even though, it is the case projected by counsel that the petitioners have been physically assaulted by a group of as many as 14 persons on 11.07.2019 but such allegation is not supported by material on record. An attempt was made to convince this Court by adverting to the documents at Annexure P-5 i.e. the MLRs as also certain photographs at Annexure P-6.

This Court has minutely perused the documents at Annexure P-5. The same do not even reveal simple injuries on the person of the petitioners.

Rather pleadings on record would bring forth that there is a dispute inter se the parties pertaining to certain passage on a piece of land

that had been sold by the respondent No.4 and purchased by the petitioners.

A civil litigation with regard to the passage has also been initiated and is pending as of date. The instant writ petition can only be seen as a fallout of civil dispute inter se the parties.

No intervention in the matter is called for.

The instant order was dictated in open Court. Faced with a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene, counsel seeks withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn
