Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.88 dated 30.07.2019 under Sections 447, 336, 427, 307 (added later on) IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Khui Khera, District Fazilka.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 24.09.2019: -

“...Counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, though the fire was shot but it hit the show of the truck and nobody was injured. It is further submitted that anticipatory bail application of co-accused of the petitioners is fixed for

01.10.2019...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the orders dated 24.09.2019 and 01.10.2019, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darshan Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners have rejoined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation and also handed over the weapon of offence.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 24.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
