Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.205, dated 24.04.2019, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

As per the allegation of the prosecution, petitioner had come to the home when deceased Roshan Lal and Pooja were talking while sitting in the house of Pooja. The petitioner objected and stated that the deceased should not have come to the house when Pooja was alone. He started abusing the deceased. Roshan Lal felt ashamed and ran away. Thereafter his dead body was found.

Petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2019. Investigations are complete and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted in Court.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the case is now fixed for prosecution evidence.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 24.04.2019, and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
