Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that after the petitioner retired from service on 31.05.2014, his dues were not being released by the respondents and ultimately, the petitioner filed a Civil Writ Petition No.13888 of 2016, which was disposed of by this Court on 18.12.2018 wherein, a direction was issued to decide the claim of the petitioner for the release of the pensionary benefits for which he is entitled after retirement. Further, a question of interest will be decided by passing a speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though after the order passed by this Court, the benefits have been released to the petitioner on 10.05.2016 but the question of interest was not decided by the respondents while releasing the said benefit and the petitioner ultimately filed a representation asking the respondents to comply with the order dated 18.12.2018 in letter and spirit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.06.2019 (Annexure P-6) claiming the

interest keeping in view the order passed by this Court on 18.12.2018, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 01.06.2019 (Annexure P-6), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 01.06.2019 (Annexure P-6), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
