The case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 06.05.2019.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received, according to which, settlement/agreement dated 02.07.2019 has been entered into between the parties. The details of the settlement are so mentioned in the said agreement which is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance to the said agreement, initial amount of ₹2 lacs has been received by respondent No. 2 and thereafter, the second installment of ₹1,50,000/- has also been paid, which fact is not disputed by the counsel for the workman-respondent No. 2.

Counsel for the parties state that the present writ petition may be disposed of in the light of the settlement/agreement dated 02.07.2019 (Mark 'A'). It has further been stated by them that the parties would be bound by the terms and conditions of the said settlement.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of.
