On 18.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.399 dated 14.11.2019, registered under Sections 406/420 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sector-56, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is doing his job in a call centre and is not connected with the online portal TripOTreasure.com, which is being run by the brother of the petitioner, namely, Prakash Jha. Hence, he submits that the petitioner is sought to be falsely implicated merely because he is brother of Sh. Prakash Jha.

of the petition be handed over to Mr.SPS Tinna, Additional

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sandeep
Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and
cooperated and he is not required for further custodial interrogation at this
stage.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.09.2019 is
made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to
cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary
adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
