Petitioner is seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned transfer order Endst. No.9227/A-2 dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) and further writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to allow him to join his new place of posting at Rewari. In this regard, had submitted representation dated 24.08.2019 (Annexure P-7), but there is no adherence thereto.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Additional Director General of Police, South Range, Rewari, to consider the representation dated 24.08.2019 (Annexure P-7), within a stipulated period.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.3, to consider the representation dated 24.08.2019 (Annexure P-7), within a period of one

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month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and shall pass a speaking order thereon, after affording opportunity of hearing to petitioner, failing which, respondent No.3, shall be liable to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to the petitioner.

This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner to run from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
