[1] Learned counsel states that claim of the petitioner is to consider him for grant of State Award on the basis of which the petitioner would be entitled to continue in service up to the age of 60 years i.e. 02 years over & above the age of retirement.

[2] Learned counsel states that in view of the impending retirement of the petitioner on 31.03.2020, the petitioner would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to the respondents to decide his representation (Annexure P-10) dated 19.08.2019 and take such further action on the same, as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case in a time bound manner.

[3] Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, states that he has no objection to the aforementioned prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] In the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-10) dated 19.08.2019 within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and take such further action in the matter within 04 weeks thereafter, as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case pursuant to the decision of the representation.
