ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 301 dated 10.08.2019, under Sections 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioners. They have been falsely implicated. He also contends that the injuries are attributed to their son, namely, Balwinder Singh, who had surrendered before the trial Court and later on was granted regular bail.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 18.09.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their

arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 18.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
