Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.188 dated 06.08.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 19.09.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant transferred the amount for applying VISA directly in the account of the agency and the allegation against the petitioner and his wife/co-accused Jaspal Kaur are that subsequently the complainant has paid an additional amount of Rs.2,50,000/- in cash and no details have been given in

the FIR. It is further submitted that co-accused of the petitioner i.e. his wife namely Jaspal Kaur has been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail vide order dated 26.08.2019 passed in CRM-M-34487-2019...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Swarn Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
