During the pendency of the proceedings a compromise has been arrived at between the parties, which states that respondent No.1 has no objection if the LPA is allowed; judgment and order passed by the learned Single Judge is set aside and writ petition filed by respondent No.1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The issue involves allotment of a site for Gas Agency. Respondent No. 1, who is present in Court, has been identified by his counsel. He has also furnished identity papers which are taken on record. Respondent No.1 expresses his desire to withdraw the writ petition filed by him which amounts to withdrawal of the claim altogether. His statement has been recorded separately.

In view of the fact that there is no opposition to the abovesaid facts we deem it appropriate to allow the LPA in terms of the said compromise and the writ stands dismissed as withdrawn.
