Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider him for further selection process for the post of Constable after examining the videography/footage of his Physical Efficiency Test as he was declared unsuccessful despite he has completed the required 14 ft. long jump.

2. Heard.

3. No grounds are made out to interfere in the extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

4. The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 01.05.2019 submitted by the petitioner and if the record has not been destroyed so far, provide him the video footage as requested by

the petitioner.

5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to re-agitate his cause, in case, as per video footage, it is apparent that he had cleared the long jump.
