Impugned herein is transfer order dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-4, whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from Jaiton Sarja to Rasulpur (B).

2. Contents of the writ petition have been perused.

3. Transfer being matter of administrative exigencies, this Court generally interferes, if at all, very cautiously. Transfer is not a punishment but an essential aspect of service, particularly, on a transferable post.

4. In my opinion, in the present case, the impugned transfer order dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) does not call for any interference from this Court in exercise of its extraordinary writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

5. Petition is disposed of with an observation that the respondents are liberty to cancel/modify the transfer order after going through the contents of the representation dated 14.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) which is stated to be pending with them.

6. Disposed of in above terms.
