In the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 15.01.2019 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2, whereby disciplinary proceedings had been decided against him.

Admittedly, the appeal of the petitioner against the abovesaid order of termination is pending and has been appended as Annexure P-5.

Counsel submits that the dispute is of the year 2000 and petitioner has suffered Acute Stroke in the year 2017 (Annexure P-2) and, therefore, seeks expeditious disposal of the said appeal.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that necessary directions are liable to be passed that respondent No.1 before whom the appeal has been filed shall dispose of the same within a period of 2 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
