Grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been granted annual increments and conveyance allowance with effect from 2008 till date, as admissible under Rules 2008. He has also not been granted benefit of additional increment on completion of four years of service under the Assured Career Progression Scheme on the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) along with arrears and interest thereupon @ 12% per annum despite the fact, he is entitled and prays for payment of the same.

2. The petitioner also caused legal notice dated 24.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) but the same has not been adverted to by the respondents. Hence the present petition.

3. Notice of motion to the respondents.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 24.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
