Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner, in FIR No.26 dated 02.02.2018, under Section 382 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur.

On 18.09.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Contends that trailer in question has already been recovered. Further contends that petitioner is ready to refund an amount of Rs.15000/- to the complainant subject to the final outcome of the present petition.

Notice of motion for 20.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him

to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, has stated that in terms of order dated 18.09.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, order dated 18.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Petition stands disposed off, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
