Petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents to allow him to join his duties with all the consequential benefits including continuity in service and back wages.

2. In the premise, petitioner submitted an application to Inspector General of Police, Zone 1, Patiala on 19.07.2019 (Annexure P-12) for joining duties. In return, he received a letter dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-13) from Inspector General of Police stating therein that he should approach SSP Patiala for joining. But still he is not allowed to join his duties. Hence, the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider his application dated 19.07.2019 (Annexure P-12) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
