On 19.9.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR
No.111 dated 30.07.2019, registered under Sections
342/323/379/506/148/149 IPC, at Police Station
Kartarpur, Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that only allegation against the petitioner is that he gave
knee blow on the back of the first informant. He submits
that petitioner is falsely implicated as he was trying to
mediate and resolve the dispute between the parties.

Notice of motion for 05.11.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.S.P.S.Tinna,
learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts
notice on behalf of the State and Mr.Amjad Khan,
Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the first informant.

Let copies of the petition be handed over to learned State counsel and learned counsel for the first informant during the course of day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 19.9.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
