The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.302 dated 12.07.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 186, 323, 332, 353 IPC and Section 42 of the Prisons Act, 1894 at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

The counsel for the State has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Munish Sehgal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala, in which it is mentioned that the petitioner was in jail at the relevant time. The incident occurred due to a gang war between two gangs of the criminals. In the said process, even the petitioner was involved and the accused caused injuries to the guard staff of the jail. The entire incident is recorded even in the CCTV footage.

In view of the above, this court does not find any *ex-facie* innocence of the accused/petitioner vis-à-vis the allegation levelled against him.

Hence, this court is not inclined to interfere to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
