ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.94 dated 16.08.2019, under Sections 370 (iv), 365, 420, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR wherein it is mentioned that two motorcyclists had kidnapped the son of the complainant. It is alleged that the petitioners had connived with the co-accused in the kidnapping of the child, who was stated to have been sold. He also contends that the child has been recovered unharmed and handed over to his parents. He further contends that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 18.09.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their

arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Devi Chand, states that although the petitioners have joined investigation but money is yet to be recovered from them.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 18.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
