Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.128 dated 04.08.2019, under Sections 326, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on the previous date of hearing i.e. 19.09.2019, passed the following order:-

“ *Contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner.*

Notice of motion for 28.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contends that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Balwinder Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 19.09.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 19.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
