Reply by way of affidavit of Ms. Anindita Mitra, Director, Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab, filed today in Court is taken on record, copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Along with the reply, an order dated 8.4.2019 is annexed whereby the claim of the petitioner has been accepted.

Learned counsel for respondent has handed over to counsel for petitioner a cheque bearing No. 000889 dated 8.11.2019 for a sum of Rs.69,750/- with regard to amount of leave encashment. He on instructions from Dr. Anjuman Bhaskar, Director, Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab submits that the rest of the benefits would be paid within six weeks from today and the respondent shall also communicate the details of calculation of the amount found due.

Learned State counsel submits that the case with regard to family pension has been sent to Accountant General and the respondent will ensure that the needful would be done within six weeks.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner is aggrieved of calculation and order dated 8.4.2019, she would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

In case the needful is not done as stated above, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
