The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents restraining them from harassing the petitioners and not to register any case against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that Baldev Singh (brother of petitioner No.1 and son of petitioners No.2 and 3) is residing with wife of Chinder Singh (Respondent No.7) and a complaint has been given by the said person against Baldev Singh with whom his wife has eloped. Learned counsel has argued that the petitioners are being harassed unnecessarily pursuant to the alleged complaint given by respondent No.7 Chinder Singh. He submits that a representation (Annexure P-2) dated 12.9.2019 was given to the Sr.Superintendent of Police, Fazilka against the alleged harassment by the officials of Police Station Vairoke.

A perusal of the representation reveals that it lacks the relevant particulars and even otherwise, if the police is looking for a person at his ordinary place of residence, then it cannot be construed as a harassment.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any valid reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
