Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') in FIR No.126 dated 01.06.2019, for offence punishable under Sections 420,120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') and 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that there is possibility of some amicable settlement and undertakes to deposit a sum of Rs. 3 Lakh on or before 30.11.2019 with the trial Court/ Illaqa Magistrate, to be kept in FDR subject to the final outcome of the case. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is in custody since 27.07.2019 and is not required for further custodial investigation. He further submits that challan has already been presented and the charges are also framed.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and on the condition that he will deposit a sum of Rs. 3 Lakh with the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate on or before 30.11.2019 and the said amount be kept in FDR subject to the final outcome of the case.
