On 19.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners pray for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.117 dated 28.07.2019, registered under Sections 452, 323, 34 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the dispute is between uncle and his nephew and the petitioners are sought to be implicated being friends of the nephew.

Notice of motion for 04.11.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.S.P.S.Tinna, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let a copy of the petition be handed-over to the learned State counsel during the course of day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

ASI Tejinder Singh, Investigating Officer present in Court, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and cooperated and they are not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 19.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioners shall continue to cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
