The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and to take appropriate action against the private respondents.

Vide order dated 19.09.2019 passed by this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the parties were directed to appear on 30.10.2019.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 19.09.2019, the parties have appeared before the Mediator and as per the report dated 16.12.2019 received from the Mediator, the parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement. The report is accompanied with the settlement/compromise dated 16.12.2019.
