The petitioner has filed a writ petition for direction to respondents for reimbursement of the medical bills for heart bypass surgery undergone in AIIMS, New Delhi. The writ petition was disposed of on 3.5.2019. The respondents were directed to pass an appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner raised in representation dated 11.2.2019. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of order.

The present contempt petition has been filed as the order has not been passed by the respondents.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Manjit Singh, Senior Assistant, O/o Development Department Vikas Bhawan, Mohali, states that a reasoned order would be passed within two weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, it is clarified that in case the petitioner is aggrieved of the order passed, he would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
