Petitioner is stated to be aged 23 years. She was married to respondent no.4 on 2.4.2019.

Counsel submits that respondent no.4 is an alcoholic and since he maltreated the petitioner and even physically abused her she was left with no option but to leave the matrimonial home and is currently in the company of one Lala at Hisar. Petitioner apprehends a threat to her life on account of the afore-noticed circumstances at the hands of respondent no.4 i.e. her husband Ashok Kumar.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without opining on the relationship/liaison of the petitioner with Lala, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.3 confined to the aspect of danger and threat to her life.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
