Petitioner prays for regular bail in FIR No.0011 dated 14.01.2019 registered under Sections 302/506/323/34/212 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, B Division, District Amritsar.

As per the case of prosecution, Goldy and Kawaljit Singh @ Rinkoo (petitioner) had given beatings to Kamaljit Singh and his friend Sikander Mohan Singh. Goldy gave a stab wound with kirch on the chest of Kamaljit Singh, due to which he fell down and Goldy, Kawaljit Singh @ Rinkoo (petitioner) and 2-3 other persons gave beatings. In a supplementary statement recorded on the same day, first informant had stated that Kawaljit Singh @ Rinkoo (petitioner) had used a sharp edged weapon to inflict injury on the buttocks of the deceased.

As per medical opinion, cause of death is due to chest injury which is not attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 25.01.2019. The investigating agency proposes to produce supplementary police report. Hence, trial is yet to commence. As per the information supplied, the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
