Grievance of the petitioners is that their service rendered on the post of SPOs was not counted towards qualifying service for the post of Constables by the respondents. They further seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant benefits of appointment as Constables along with all consequential benefits from the date of completion of six months service as SPOs as per standing Order/Government Instructions dated 30.10.1990 and 19.11.1991 Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3, respectively.

2. The petitioners also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-9), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if the legal notice dated 11.06.2018 (Annexure P-9) is disposed of expeditiously.
