Present petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 02.07.2019 (P-4) passed by Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, to the extent vide which the petitioner has been asked to deposit 20% of the compensation amount passed in Criminal Appeal No. 152/2019, titled M/s Bansi Foods Rice Mill and another Vs. M/s Gurditta Mal Sham Sunder, instituted on 02.07.2019 against the judgment dated 11.06.2019 (P-1) vide which the petitioner has been convicted and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for one year and fine as equivalent amount to the cheque amount.

On 19.09.2019, this Court while issuing notice of motion, passed the following order:-

“Contends that 20% of the compensation amount in question, in terms of order dated 02.07.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions

Judge, Karnal, shall be deposited within a period of 2 weeks from today.

Notice of motion returnable on 30.10.2019.

Dasti as well.

To be shown in the urgent list.”

Today, at the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in terms of order dated 19.09.2019, petitioners have already made the payment of 20% of compensation amount to complainant- respondent No.2.

The above factual position has been duly acknowledged by learned counsel representing respondent No.2.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed off as such.
