Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 262 dated 22.12.2017 registered under Sections 15/18/21/22/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station, Cantt., Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Petitioner is a proclaimed person. As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner had run away when search and seizure of his house was carried out and 270 grams heroin was found in possession of the wife of the petitioner. The petitioner is a previous convict under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act. There are as many as 12 criminal cases under the Excise Act against the petitioner.

In view thereof, no ground is made out to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.
