Petitioner-Rano has filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to official respondents to seek custody of detenu-Mohd.Hanif son of Mohd.Bashir who is in illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

On 17.09.2019, notice of motion was issued to respondent Nos.1 and 8 only.

In response to the petition, reply by way of affidavit of Satinder Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondent No.8 has been filed. The relevant paragraph of the reply is extracted below:-

“That it is humbly submitted that on 19.09.2019, at about 11 PM the police officials of P.S.City, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala gave information to the police of P.S.Haryana, District

Hoshiarpur on phone that Mohammad Haneef son of Rano petitioner is admitted in Civil Hospital, Kapurthala on 19.09.2019 at about 10.30 PM. On this, the police officials of P.S.Haryana went to Civil Hospital Kapurthala on 20.09.2019 at about 2 AM and Mohammad Haneef son of the petitioner was discharged by the doctor of Civil Hospital, Kapurthala. Thereafter, Mohammad Haneef son of Rano petitioner was brought to the police station Haryana on 20.09.2019, Rano present petitioner was called to the police station Haryana by the police official of P.S. Haryana. On this, Rano petitioner, her husband Mohammad Bashir and Lal Husaain brother-in-law of petitioner came to the police station Haryana on 20.09.2019 and Mohammad Haneef son of Rano petitioner was handed over to them on the same day, at about 9 AM.”

In view of the above stand of the official respondents, present petition is rendered infructuous.
