Petitioner-Sunil Jindal has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of the impugned FIR No.032 dated 18.02.2018 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Faridkot.

On 24.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

*“Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the status of investigation in FIR No.032 dated 18.02.2018, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Faridkot. Counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply requisite sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.*

*Adjourned to 29.10.2019.”*

Today, learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Gurpreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Faridkot, District Faridkot on behalf of respondent-State wherein it is mentioned that the investigation of the FIR is complete and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C stands filed before learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot on 28.11.2019. The case is now fixed before the trial Court for 20.12.2019.

Since the final report is pending consideration, therefore, this Court does not find any reason to invoke the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
