The co-accused of the petitioner (both of them admittedly being juvenile even as per learned State counsel, on instructions from an official who is present to assist her), having been released on bail by the trial court itself on September 20, 2019, I see no reason to keep the petitioner further in custody, with no other criminal case stated to have been registered against him (again as per the instructions of learned State counsel).

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court.
