Petitioner, a public limited company, is engaged in the business of manufacturing of auto and machine parts. It is also registered as a dealer under Haryana Value Added Tax Act, 2003 as also Central Sales Tax Act, 1956.

The prayer in the present writ petition was for issuance of direction to refund the claim of excess balance portion of the unutilized input tax credit for the month of August, 2017 shown in the electric ledgers of the petitioner company under the GST regime.

Upon notice of motion, Mr. Sourabh Goel, Advocate had appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and sought time to seek instructions.

At the time of resumed hearing today, counsel for the parties agreed that the present petition has become infructuous as the necessary refund has since been sanctioned and released to the petitioner company.
